Dear Colleagues,

The Corporation for National and Community Service (CNCS) has updated its Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) and guidance on submitting alternative search procedures (ASPs) and exemptions.

The FAQs contain updates related to the anticipated start of services of a Channeler for FBI checks in January 2016 and a revision of the questions that discuss whether or not contractors are required to undergo the criminal history check process.

The ASP and exemption guidance has been updated to enhance clarity and accessibility, and to reflect changes as a result of the anticipated start of services of the Channeler.
