The Puerto Rico sex offender registry began reporting to [NSOPW.gov](http://NSOPW.gov) again on October 10, 2017 around 12:00 PM EDT.

The [exemption](#) CNCS granted on September 22, 2017 remains in place in case the Puerto Rico sex offender registry becomes unresponsive again as disaster recovery continues.

As a reminder, grant recipients must re-conduct all NSOPW checks performed during the time the Puerto Rico sex offender registry was not reporting to NSOPW.gov **by November 15, 2017**. (See the original GovDelivery message [here](#).)

CNCS encourages all grant recipients to take this opportunity to re-conduct any NSOPW checks that did not reflect a search of the Puerto Rico sex offender registry. The supplemental NSOPW check must reflect a search of the Puerto Rico sex offender registry by the November 15 deadline. You must maintain both the on-time, incomplete NSOPW and the supplemental NSOPW results.
